10/26-27 National Industrial Fastener & Mill Supply Expo

"The 2015 exhibitors are being assigned by priority points and log in at appointed times to select their booths. 85% of the companies have met their appointments and selected booths and we already have contracts from several new companies. In addition, nearly 10% of the returning companies are expanding their booth space", informs Susan A. Hurley, CEM, Show Director.

3/30-31 Fastener Fair Turkey No. 1534

Following continuing strong demand for stand space, the first of the two exhibition halls that will host Fastener Fair Turkey 2016 is already fully booked. Exhibitors are now being assigned stands in a second hall at the IFM - Istanbul Expo Centre. The introduction of a second hall means that the third of these exhibitions in Istanbul will be an even bigger and better showcase for the latest in fastener and fixing products and systems. Half of those were either wholesalers or distributors. The majority of attendees were based in Turkey, but a significant number – 25% – were foreign, representing 47 countries.



5/12-15 Myanmar Int'l Building Material, Hardware & Tool Exhibition

Over 125 exhibitors from more than 15 countries such as Taiwan, China, South Korea, Hong Kong, Austria, Germany, Myanmar, Indonesia, Thailand, Vietnam, Singapore, Italy and Malaysia will occupy some 260 booths across 8,000 square meters. The building material show will include zones focusing on tool & accessory, lock & fitting, fastener & fitting, building supplies, garden & outdoor equipment, automotive supply and accessory, machine & plant equipment, safety equipment & product, building technology...

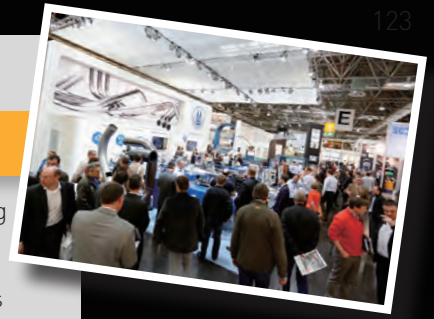

Germany

3/6-8 International Hardware Fair Cologne *Hall 5.2 D-061*

International Hardware Fair Cologne announced new conceptual moves at the beginning of the year including the changed schedule and the premiere of the DIY Boulevard. Registrations have been received from renowned exhibitors from home and abroad, including also several returned exhibitors. Compared to the same period of the previous year, the level of internationality has also increased by over 15 percent.



4/4-8 Wire Düsseldorf *No. 15B10*

Covering a net exhibition space of currently about 58,600 square metres, "wire" will feature machinery for the production and finishing of wire, tools and auxiliary materials in process engineering as well as materials, special wires and cables. The trade fair will also cover innovations in measurement and control engineering, test engineering and special areas. So far 920 companies from 46 countries have registered.



Japan

4/19-21 M-Tech Nagoya

In the 1st edition, the show is expected to gather 700 exhibitors and 25,000 visitors from all around the world. Reasons to launch the 1st edition in Nagoya are strong requests from existing exhibitors to hold an exhibition in central Japan to widen sales, inquiries from automotive/aerospace/machinery/medical device manufacturers in Nagoya area, and projections of exhibitor numbers (700 companies in its debut) with growth potential. According to the high demand for exhibiting space from the manufacturing industry, the show management has added more exhibit space for 200 companies after primary recruiting.

10/05-07 M-Tech Osaka

M-Tech Osaka is Western Japan's largest exhibition gathering all kinds of mechanical parts such as bearings, fasteners, mechanical springs and metal and plastic processing technology. The previous 2015 edition of 3-day M-Tech Osaka attracted the enthusiastic attendance of 1,063 exhibitors and 42,216 visitors, a 14% increase from the 2014 edition.

India

5/19-20 Fastener Fair India *No. A36*

Fastener Fair India 2015 attracted 4,181 visitors; an increase of 17.5% from the previous show. The two day event fixed on a net space of some 1,500m² had 128 exhibitors from 8 different countries. The majority of exhibitors were India based companies. However, many were from outside India, namely from China, Taiwan, Germany, Italy, Malaysia and the USA. The exhibitors showcased a comprehensive range of industrial fasteners and fixings, assembly and installation systems, storage and logistics services, fastener manufacturing technology and construction fixings.

Australia

5/4-6 DesignBUILD *No. M44*

DesignBUILD, built for the industry, is the only dedicated architecture, building and design trade event in Australia. Now entering its 30th year, DesignBUILD attracts over 7,000 industry professionals to this exhibition which comprises hundreds of new products, and showcases more than 500 brands. In the 2015 edition in Sydney, it attracted 262 exhibiting companies and 5,107 visitors in total.
